

A universal assessment of language skills

The WS test results use the Bright scale from 0 to 5, correlated to the CEFR*.

Bright Score	CEFRL Level	Skills

0,5	- A1	Can recognize familiar words and very basic phrases concerning self, family and immediate concrete surroundings when people speak slowly and clearly. Can write a short, simple postcard, for example sending holiday greetings. Can fill in forms with personal details, for example entering name, nationality and address on a hotel registration form.

1,5	A2	family information, shopping, local area, employment). Can catch the main point in short, clear, simple messages and announcements.
2	A2+	
2,5	B1	Can understand texts that consist mainly of high frequency everyday or job- related language. Can understand the description of events, feelings and wishes in personal letters. Can write simple connected text on topics which are familiar or of personal interest. Can write personal letters describing experiences and impressions.
3	B1+	
3,5	B2	Can understand extended speech and lectures and follow even complex lines of argument provided the topic is reasonably familiar. Can understand most TV news and current affairs programmes. Can understand the majority of films in standard dialect. Can write clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects related to interests. Can write an essay or report, passing on information or giving reasons in support of or against a particular point of view. Can write letters highlighting the personal significance of events and experiences.

4,5	C1	Can understand extended speech even when it is not clearly structured and when relationships are only implied and not signalled explicitly. Can understand television programmes and films without too much effort. Can write well- structured text, expressing points of view at some length. Can write about complex subjects in a letter, an essay or a report, underlining salient issues. Can select a style appropriate to the reader in mind.
5	C2	Can without difficulty understand any kind of spoken language, whether live or broadcast, even when delivered at fast native speed, given time to get familiar with the accent. Can write clear, smoothly flowing text in an appropriate style. Can write complex letters, reports or articles which present a case with an effective logical structure which helps the recipient to notice and remember significant points. Can write summaries and reviews of professional or literary works.
