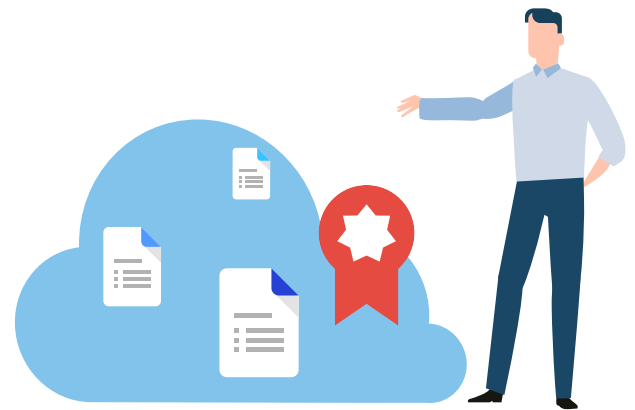

What is it?

The Bright test is the central pillar for all our tests and consists of a written/oral online questionnaire in two parts comprising 60 questions each. The average duration of the test is 45 to 60 minutes or a set time can be applied, as decided by you.

11 languages currently available : English, French, Spanish, Italian, German, Portuguese, Dutch, Flemish, Swedish, Russian, and Mandarin Chinese.

How does it work?

The whole process takes place on our online platform. Candidates access the test interface using the personal identifier emailed to them.

The examinee has 45 seconds to answer questions from the written section and 60 seconds for questions from the oral section with the possibility of listening to the question again within the set time. There is only one correct answer and it is not possible to go back to questions.

Results are graded on a scale of 0 (beginner) to 5 (bilingual) and are correlated with the CECFR levels. Bright Language can compare them against the language competencies required for different roles within your business.
